



MISSION STATEMENT

PURPOSE:

The purpose of the Club is to enjoy Corvettes, time with our friends and have fun. Our members are encouraged to suggest ideas for club events, such as: meetings, cruise-ins, displays, rallies, picnics and of course anything that promotes driving our cars, eating and good fellowship.

MEMBERSHIP:

To be a member you must own a Corvette. Membership runs from the first day of January to the end of December of each year. The membership fee is \$35.00 per couple or \$30.00 per individual, or as set from time to time by the board. Membership fees must be paid within the first two months of each year. Any member whose actions are detrimental to the good standing of the club may be dismissed by a vote of the majority of the members.

CLUB STRUCTURE:

The Triad Corvette Club shall have a board made up of a President, Vice-President, Treasurer and Secretary. Together they will manage the club's business and bring all business issues to the membership for voting.

The President shall have the responsibility of presiding at all meetings of the club members. He/she, along with the other board members, shall have the responsibility of the general and active management of the business of the club and shall see that all orders of the club membership are carried into effect.

The Vice President shall have the responsibility of performing the duties of the President in the absence of the President and shall perform such other duties as the club membership shall prescribe.

The Secretary shall attend all club meetings. He/she shall record in a minute book all of the proceedings of the meetings and make them available to the members on the website. He/she shall have custody of all organizational documents of the club and the minute books and shall pass such information on to his/her successor.

The Treasurer shall have custody of all club membership funds. He/she shall be responsible for the club checking account and shall keep in books belonging to the club full and accurate records of all receipts and disbursements. He/she shall pass all such information on to his/her successor.

A webmaster will be assigned to be in charge of the club's website. This person will be responsible for keeping all club events and club business posted on the club's website and up to date.

A hospitality coordinator will be assigned to welcome new members and share with the club any news concerning the health or well being of our members. He/she will be responsible for sending cards and/or flowers upon approval by the club.

All voting issues will be presented at a regular monthly meeting. The membership will be the voting body. To vote a member must be in good standing and be in attendance at the meeting. There will be no absentee voting. A majority of votes casts will be the deciding factor and it will be the members' responsibility to accept the majority's decision.

CLUB MEETINGS AND EVENTS:

Regular monthly meetings will be held on the third Friday of each month at 6:30 PM, except December. The location will be announced on the website or delivered via email to club members. In December we will have a Christmas Party and no meeting.

A fellowship dinner will be held the first Friday of each month at 6:30pm at a location to be announced via email the preceding week. In addition, there will be a planned club event each month with the Christmas Party being the event for December.
